1. Holder of the represented country.
2. Holder of recommendation and recognition of the National Association.
3. Holder Poom or Dan Kukkiwon Certificate
4. Holder of the WTF Global Athlete (GAL) 2016
5. Holder of PATU Coach Certificate for Coaches.

Participants:

All the participants must be nationality holders of the represented country. Every contestant is required to present a Member National Association endorsement for competition.

Coaches Qualifications

The minimum qualification requirements for coaches are as follows:

- All coaches must be at least 18 years of age.
- All Coaches / Trainers must be holders of the PATU Coach Certificate (granted by participation in a PATU Coach Seminar). Coaches / Trainers that do not have the PATU Coach License shall pay a \$300.00 (USD) fine at the registration desk.





Coaches Dress Code

During all the competition all coaches are obliged to wear a formal suit. Coaches that do not follow the dress code cannot be entered into the field of play.

Sport Equipment

The Organizing Committee will provide electronic chest protectors for all the athletes. Each athlete is responsible for its own electronic socks for the competition.

DAEDO PSS System will be used for all categories starting in cadets.

All the athletes are responsible of bringing their own head protectors, gloves, electronic socks, arm, shin and oral protectors.

Official Uniform (Dobok)

All contestants are required to use white taekwondo uniform (dobok) with "V" neck from PATU/WTF recognized brands, in good conditions.

Black Belts must use black necks.

Patches, embroidery, logos, team names, countries, athletes' names and strikes are allowed. No tape is allowed in part of the uniform.

Protection Equipment

All athletes must use recognized protection equipment, as well as recognized headgears (Hong in red and Chung in blue), oral protector, groin guard, forearm shin and in-step protectors by the time of entering the competition area.

Groin guard, forearm and shin protections must be inside of the Taekwondo uniform.

It is prohibited any extra object on the head additional to the headgear. Any religious article must be prior approved and must be used under the headgear, inside the dobok and must not cause any type of obstruction or lack of visibility for the opponent.





Points for medal

GOLDEN Medal	7 Pts
SILVER Medal	3 Pts
BRONZE Medal	1 Pto

Entre fee, terms and conditions for contestants

All airfares, accommodation and board must be covered for each contestant or Member National Association.

- 1) **100 USD** Fee to be paid for 1 competition event.
- 2) **160 USD** Fee to be paid for 2 competition events.

Referees

- PATU will appoint the total amount of required International Referees.
- International Referees are required to pay for their own round-trip airfares.
- The Organizing Committee shall pay for the expenses for four (4) nights' stay of room and board.
- The Organizing Committee shall pay a per diem of US\$100 per competition day. (total 2 days; US\$200 per referee).

Weigh-in

- Athletes weigh-in will take place 1 day prior to each division competition day
- During the weigh-in, the male athlete shall wear underpants and the female athlete shall wear underpants and brassiere.
- However, the athlete may weigh in nude if he/she wishes to do so.



Local Transportation

- Organizing Committee will not provide local transportation for the participating teams, each team is responsible of their own accurate transportation. Organizing Committee will only provide this service to Referees, VIPs, and PATU Officials.

Medical Services

- Organizing Committee will only provide medical services for emergencies during competition if any injury is suffered.
- Contestants are responsible for further injury and hospitalization expenses.
- Organizing Committee recommends to all contestants to have an updated medical insurance and have all the information available at any time.
