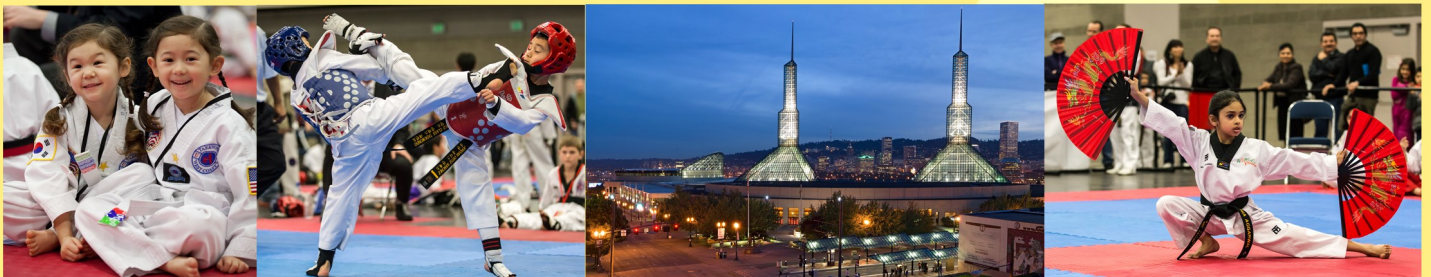

## ENTRY FEES, TERMS & CONDITIONS OF PARTICIPATION:

1. Round trip airfares and room and board expenses shall be borne by all participants.
2. Competition Entry fee for **COLOR BELTS** - \$80.00 USD for one event. \$50.00 for each additional event before October 25, 2015.
3. Competition Entry fee for **BLACK BELTS** - \$130.00 USD for one event. \$70.00 for each additional event before October 25, 2015.
4. Demonstration Team - \$300.00 USD. (up to 10 people per team)
5. Coach & Media Pass fee - \$100.00 USD before October 25, 2015. Coach fee is waived to all Coaches with current PATU Intercontinental Coach Certification.
6. Late registration fee of \$50 will be added to all registration from October 26 – November 1, 2015 with no exceptions.
7. Spectator admission - \$15.00 per day. 5 years and under \$7.00 per day. Infants free. Pay at the venue box office on competition dates.

## OFFICIAL UNIFORMS:

All Black Belt sparring competitors must wear WTF Approved Black v-neck uniform (White Dobok) in good condition. Color belt sparring contestants are required to wear, WTF White V-neck White uniform. For all other color belt contestants, colored uniforms are allowed for all events other than Sparring. Patches, embroidery, logos, team names, country names, athlete names, and stripes are permitted on uniforms. **NO TAPE WILL BE ALLOWED ON ANY PART OF THE UNIFORM.**

## SPARRING EQUIPMENT:

Organizer will be using Daedo Electronic Body Protectors & E Headgears for **all Black Belts**. All black belt athletes can rent Daedo Chest protectors & E Headgears for \$25.00 for the duration of the sparring event. PATU will provide complementary use of Daedo Chest protectors and E Headgears to all athletes coming from outside of United States. All Black Belt competitors are **REQUIRED** to purchase and use their own Daedo sensor socks for the sparring event(s). Daedo **heel sensor will be needed** at this event due to the use of E Headgears. Daedo sensor socks can be purchased by visiting the Daedo sales booth at the event. All athletes will be responsible for supplying their own headgear (unless E Head gears is used), gloves, foot pads, arm and shin guards, and mouth guards.

## PROTECTIVE EQUIPMENT:

Contestants shall wear an approved trunk protector, headgear (white, or red for Hong and blue for Chung), groin guard (optional for female competitors), gloves (see below), forearm protector, shin-instep protectors, sensor socks (if using an electronic Protector and Scoring System), and mouth guard before entering the contest area. No eye glasses or goggles, prescription or nonprescription allowed.

## PROTECTIVE GLOVES:

All Black Belts are required to wear WTF-approved Taekwondo gloves. Gloves may be red, blue, or white while white is preferred. Competitors who choose to wear red or blue gloves must correspond with the color of the chest protector. Gloves must be open finger style. For all other divisions, gloves are optional and must comply with the above rule.

## KNEE & ELBOW PADS:

The use of kneepads and/or elbow pads is **OPTIONAL**. Kneepads or elbow pads, if worn, must be foam, cloth, or vinyl, and must be worn under the Taekwondo uniform. Any colors are allowed.

## MOUTH GUARD:

All athletes are **REQUIRED** to wear mouth guards. A mouth cover may be used for those with braces if an orthodontist's note is provided prior to the beginning of competition. Clear or White mouth guards only.

## HEADGEAR:

All sparring participants must provide their own white or red AND blue headgear with no markings other than corporate logos. If the competitor chooses to wear red or blue headgear, it must correspond with the color of the chest protector. Competitors will not be permitted to wear headgears with cracks or defects. There is no exception to this policy.

## PROTECTIVE CUP:

All male athletes are **REQUIRED** to wear a protective cup inside the pants during competition. Groin protection is optional for female athletes; and must be worn inside the uniform pants.

## SHIN & INSTEP PROTECTION:

Shin and instep protectors are **REQUIRED**, and they must be made of foam, cloth or vinyl. When available, Daedo sensor socks with built-in instep padding will also be allowed. If an athlete chooses to wear foam padding, it must be taped on and it must cover the area from the base of the toes, over the top of the instep to the side of the foot, with no more than two layers of tape. Daedo Heel sensor is needed for all Black Belt Sparring Competitors. Additional shin or instep protection must be approved and stamped by the Sports Medicine Department for the purpose of protecting an injury.

## FOREARM GUARDS:

Forearm guards are **REQUIRED** and it is mandatory that athletes wear only foam, cloth, or vinyl products. Any color forearm guard will be allowed.

*Please Note: Organizer reserves the right to disallow any uniform or equipment if it is found to be offensive or degrading in any fashion.*

## WTF INTERNATIONAL REFEREES:

- Organizer will appoint the required number of WTF International Referees. **Referees who are interested in officiating at this event must apply through contacting Master MC Kim - [mckim0190910@aol.com](mailto:mckim0190910@aol.com) by September 25, 2015.**
- Roundtrip Airfare shall be borne by each participating International Referee.
- The Organizing Committee shall cover (3) nights of room and board expenses (check-in in early afternoon on November 5; check-out before Noon on November 8, 2015). *Please note, referee meeting and training will be held in the morning on November 6, 2015. International Referees must arrive and be available before 10am on November 6, 2015.*
- The Organizing Committee shall provide each participating WTF International Referee with an honorarium of US\$300.00 for the event.

## WEIGH-IN:

- Weigh-in for All Black Belt athletes shall be completed one day before the sparring event date.
- At weigh-in, male contestants must wear a minimal of underpants and female athletes must wear a minimal of underpants & brassieres.
- Maximum Two weigh in attempts will be allowed.
- All Weight Change requests before November 1, 2015 will be subjected to a \$25 weight change fee.
- No Weight Change can be made until weigh in date after November 1, 2015.
- Weight change is allowed for \$100 at weigh in.

### KYORUGI COMPETITION:

#### All Ages & All Color Belts:

Single elimination bracket, 2 Rounds, 1 minute round with 30 second rest period.

#### 6-7 and 8-9 Year Old Black Belt:

Single elimination bracket, 2 Rounds, 1 minute round with 30 second rest period.

#### 10-11 Year Old and Cadet Division (12-14 Year Olds) Black Belt:

Single elimination bracket, 2 Rounds, 90 second round with 30 second rest period.

#### JUNIOR DIVISIONS (15-17 Year Olds) BLACK BELTS:

Single elimination bracket, 3 Rounds, 90 second round with 30 second rest period.

\*Athletes are not permitted to enter more than one weight category, per age division.

\*\*Athletes must compete in their age divisions that they fall in. An Athlete cannot compete "Up or Down" in age & weight divisions with the exception of 17 year old black belt competitors who will be permitted to spar in the senior (18-32 yo) division.



## Poomsae Guidelines

### COMPETITION RULES:

WTF/PATU Poomsae Competition Rules will apply.

### METHOD OF COMPETITION:

All Color Belt Poomsae competitors will compete in 1 Round of Compulsory Poomsae of their choice. Contestants shall perform one(1) compulsory Poomsae, and the top four contestants/pairs/team shall be awarded prizes based on their points. Please see compulsory Poomsae list for further information.

### Cut-off system for Black Belts Only:

The cut-off system shall comprise the Preliminary, Semi-Final, and Final rounds.

1) Preliminaries: When 20 or more competitors are participating; competition shall start from the Preliminary round with division of groups at different rings, and may be judged by different judges. Competitors shall perform one(1) designated compulsory Poomsae, and the top 8 of each group shall advance to Semi-Final based on the highest scores.

2) Semi-Final selection: When 9 to 19 competitors are participating; competition shall start from the Semi-Final round. Competitors shall perform one(1) designated compulsory Poomsae, and 8 of them shall be advanced to Final based on the highest scores.

3) Final: When 8 or fewer competitors are participating, competition shall start from the Final Round. Competitors shall perform two(2) designated compulsory Poomsae, and the top four individual competitors/pairs/team shall be awarded prizes based on their total points in the final round. In the case of a tie, competitor with the higher total presentation points wins. 3rd and 4th places are awarded with bronze medals.

**\*Each individual competitor will only be allowed to compete in a maximum of 2 Poomsae divisions; excluding Demo Team.**

## Board Breaking Guidelines

Male and Female Age Groups	Belt Groups
4 - 5 year olds and 6-7 year olds	Yellow
8-9 year olds	Green
10-11 year olds	Blue
12-14 year olds	Red
15-17 year olds and 18 year & Over	Black

**Distance (Flying Side Kick) Breaking:** Winner will be the participant who jumps the farthest while breaking one regulation sized board.

**\*The Organizing Committee will provide demo boards to be used by all competitors in the competitions. Absolutely NO personal boards will be allowed. Assigned referees will hold boards for athletes. Coaches will not be allowed in the competition area during the execution of the Flying Side Kick.**

**DEMONSTRATION TEAM COMPETITION:** Registration Fee / \$300.00 USD per Team

1. Maximum set up time is 1 minute & clean up time is 1 minute.
2. The maximum time to complete the demonstration is 8 Minutes.
3. The demonstration should be done in the 8m x 8m area as governed by the WTF.
4. Minimum of three members and no more than 10 members, including board holders.
5. Music and the reproductive system to be provided by the demonstration team are allowed on the mats during the performances.
6. No pyrotechnics, fireworks or rockets.
7. Weapons or other accessories shall be provided by the demonstration team.
8. No tables or chairs are allowed.
9. WTF approved uniforms must be worn by the entire team including board holders.

The score of the demonstration will be based on the following order of superiority in ascending order:

1. Synchronization technique (20%).
2. Excitement on the performance (20%).
3. Successful completion of Taekwondo techniques (20%).
4. Entertainment generated (20%).
5. Display of Precision, Speed and Power (20%).

Contestants may compete in more than one category of competition unless it is limited by gender.
