Categories	Cadets Male and Female (12 – 14 years). Juniors Male and Female (15 – 17 years). Seniors Male and Female 17 years and older. Juniors born in 2005 compete either as a junior or as a senior. Competing in both categories is <u>not allowed</u>.
Ages	SENIORS: An athlete must be born in 2005 and older (+17 years); JUNIORS: Year of Birth (2005 – 2007); CADETS: Year of Birth (2008 – 2010).
Weight Divisions	Senior Male: -54, -58, -63, -68, -74, -80, -87, +87. Senior Female: -46, -49, -53, -57, -62, -67, -73, +73.

Junior Male: -45, -48, -51, -55, -59, -63, -68, -73, -78, +78.
Junior Female: -42, -44, -46, -49, -52, -55, -59, -63, -68, +68.
Cadet Male: -33, -37, -41, -45, -49, -53, -57, -61, -65, +65.

ELEGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

Athletes	All participants must have a valid 2022 WT Global License in order to participate at this event. Please contact your MNA or club admin to apply for the WT Global License.
Coaches	1- Minimum age of 18 years. 2- WT Coach Certificate Level I or above is required; 3- Holder of a valid 2022 WT Global License. 4- Coach is not allowed wearing Dobok. 5- 1 coach per 5 athletes is allowed. Exceeding this ratio is subject to an extra fee.
Referees	An official invitation for the referees will be sent to all Federations. There will be transportation for arrival and departure (airport X hotel X airport) for all the referees only arriving to the International Airport of Galeão (GIG).

RULES

Method of Competition	Competition will be WT Rules. Single elimination tournament.
Seeding	Seniors will be seeded according to 2022 WT ranking list.
WT Global License	All participants must have a valid 2022 WT Global License in order to participate at this event. Please contact your MNA or club admin to apply for the WT Global License.
Contest Time:	i. Seniors: 3 rounds of 2' minutes with 1' minute break ii. Juniors: 3 rounds of 1'30" minutes with 1' minute break iii. Cadets: 2 rounds of 1'30" minutes with 1' minute break (contest times could be adjusted according to WT TD Decisions)
Belt Requirements	All ages 1 Dan and Above.
Protective Equipment & Uniform	The participants shall wear WT recognized Taekwondo Uniform. Daedo PSS will be used at this Tournament and will be provided by the OC. All athletes must bring their own Daedo sensor socks and their own full equipment and guards except body protector. Mouthpiece is compulsory! (Only white or transparent) Cadets with flexi glass has to have a mouthpiece mandatory. Contestants' uniforms and protectors, please check on WT competition rules: Article 4-2 to 2.5.

NOTE: WT Global License is mandatory for all age categories

All fees must be paid in DOLLAR'S and please ensure you pay any additional currency charges. If the athlete registered on-line does not take part in the competition, but he/she has not been removed from the list of participants before the deadline his/her team or official must fully (100%) pay his/her Entry fee for participation.

Proof of Payment Required. Athlete sport entries may be deleted if no payment has been received. Each team shall inform of their entry fee payment by submitting the transfer slip before the registration and payment deadline at payment.riopen@cbtkd.org.br

WEIGHT IN, SCHEDULE & LOCATION

Weigh-in of the contestants shall be completed the day before their scheduled competition. Weigh in period could be extended or adjusted by WT TD decision accordingly.

During the weigh-in, senior contestants shall wear under pants and female contestants shall wear underpants and brassieres. However, contestants may weigh-in in the nude if they want to do so. Cadet and Junior athletes cannot weigh-in nude. Male contestants shall wear underpants and female contestants shall wear underpants and brassieres.

HEAD OF TEAM MEETING

The Head of Team Meeting at 2022 Rio Open Taekwondo Championships will be at Venit Hotel at 07:00 PM. All information will be published on the social media platforms and WhatsAppgroup.

LIABILITY

By registering for the Rio Open all contestants accept the rules and conditions of participation set by the organizing committee. All contestants will participate at their own risk. The Organizer could not be responsible for any loss or damage to individuals or equipment under no circumstances.

Liability waivers must be signed by participants (or by parent or legal guardian for athletes ages 18 and under) prior to the release of credentials at check-in. You will not receive a credential without turning in a signed waiver.

AWARDS

Medals will be awarded to the top four athletes in the respective classifications and weight divisions of the pertinent championships. The medal ceremony will take place IMMEDIATELY after the end of the final fights of certain categories. All fights will take place according to a predetermined schedule.

1st PLACE: GOLD MEDAL & CERTIFICATE
2nd PLACE: SILVER MEDAL & CERTIFICATE
3rd PLACE: BRONZE MEDAL & CERTIFICATE
3rd PLACE: BRONZE MEDAL & CERTIFICATE

DOPING CONTROL

The WT Anti-Doping Rules and the WADA Anti-Doping Code are applicable. Compulsory random doping tests will be conducted among all athletes. World Taekwondo and/or WADA may carry out random out-of-competition testing prior to the event.

ACCOMODATION

For information about accommodation please check the Accommodation guide released.

COVID MANDATORY MEASURES AND PROTOCOLS

All participants must present either: fully vaccinated, or have a negative PCR or antigen test of less than 72 hours; or a certificate of recovery from Covid-19.

The organizer of the competition, Brazilian Taekwondo Federation will act in accordance with local laws and regulations, as well as follows the recommendations of government public health services to reduce the risk to a minimum. Continuous risk assessments, and monitoring of the situation and

its changes at the national, and especially at the local level, will ensure valid compliance with the recommended and mandatory health and safety regulations and measures.

The organizer of the competition has taken a clear position and has a policy of personal responsibility. This position takes into account the legal aspects related to the organization of the competition during the pandemic and is made public to athletes, representatives and professional accompaniment of competitors and all those involved in the organization.

Travel

Rules for those arriving by plane, foreign and Brazilian travelers abroad must present to the airline responsible for the flight, before boarding:

- 1) Proof of negative or undetectable test for Covid-19 antigen test (performed within 24 hours prior to departure); or RT-PCR laboratory test (performed within 72 hours prior to departure). In the case of a flight with connections or stopovers in which the traveler leaves the restricted area of the airport and/or performs migration, and which exceeds 72 hours from the RT-PCR test or the 24 hours from the antigen test, the traveler must present a document proving the performance of a new test.
- 2) Traveler's Health Declaration – DSV: proof, printed or electronically, of completing the declaration at most 24 hours before departure to Brazil.
- 3) Proof of vaccination:
 - a. must be printed or electronically; (proofs that are exclusively in QR-CODE format will not be accepted);
 - b. must contain the name of the traveler, the commercial name or name of the vaccine manufacturer, the number(s) of the lot(s) of the applied dose(s) and the date(s) of application of the dose(s);
 - c. vaccines approved by Anvisa, the World Health Organization (WHO) or the authority of the country in which the traveler was immunized are valid.
 - d. the application of the single dose or the last dose of the primary vaccination schedule must have occurred at least 14 days before the date of departure.

* Documents issued abroad must be presented in Portuguese, Spanish or English.

In order to avoid or reduce interactions between persons, the number of those who can attend the event is limited to only those necessary for the functioning of the hall, the event, and the competition itself. All associates are required to adhere to measures and recommendations to prevent the transmission of coronavirus infection.

Wearing a protective mask in such a way that it covers both mouth, and nose is mandatory for all associates regardless of their place of action. Masks should be worn at any time without exception, except in the case of competitors, during the competition (during fights).

This rulebook is designed for and binds all participants in the organization who accept the stated instructions by taking over the official accreditation.

Participants/implementation/audience

In order to facilitate the use of this document, the organizer divided all participants in the organization into groups related to movement within the competition zone and participants outside the competition zone.

- Competition zone (Arena)
- Competitors / participants
- Referees / delegates / organizers / technical service
- Medical procedures / Warming places
- TV broadcast of the competition
- Anti-doping control

- Volunteers

Other participants in the organization who are outside the competition zone of movement (in front of the hall and hotel space)

- Employees
- Transport service / official drivers
- Physiotherapists / masseurs / medical service
- Media representatives
- Security service
- Logistics / goods acceptance / accreditation service
- Serving food
- Official accommodation

Wearing a protective mask is mandatory at all times, except in the following situations:

- During a meal at the hotel, during the warm-up and during the fights.

Weigh in

Weigh in will take place at the hotel in the designated rooms, and each team will receive a weigh in schedule to avoid unnecessary gatherings. All participants who attend the official weigh-in are required to disinfect their hands and wear a protective mask before entering the room. The same goes for the official staff during weigh-in (referees).

Accreditation

The space for accreditation and registration will be available for those who make reservation in designated desk in front of the accreditation room.

Competition zone

No close contact is allowed in the hall after the competition, and this refers to shaking hands, hugging or kissing for the purpose of celebrating the results of the performance.

The medal ceremony will take place IMMEDIATELY after the end of the final fights of certain categories. All fights will take place according to a predetermined schedule.

Person who will give awards and medals as well as award winners (athletes) are required to use masks during the ceremony. The ceremony will take place without a handshake, and the person presenting the awards must also wear gloves.

Referees / delegates / organizers / technical service

After each category, the tatami mat should be wiped and sprayed with disinfectant.

Equipment (helmet and body protector)

Should be sprayed with disinfectant after the fight, and the same cannot be used for the next 2 fights. Persons in charge of collecting, transporting, and returning the equipment should clean their hands with disinfectant or use disposable gloves and throw them away after handling the equipment.

Medical procedures / Warming places

Every person must be considered potentially contagious; therefore, athletes and medical staff are required to wear protective equipment at all times. Asking for autographs or taking photos with athletes is not recommended,

Return PCR test

For international flights, some passengers may have to submit PCR test. If you wish, you can have your Team tested in hotel. For those who would like PCR test should inform OC at accreditation of the team at the hotel.

In any change of the Brazilian legislation in force, the information will be updated and disclosed.

INSURANCE & INDEMNITIES

Insurance	The organizing committee and supervisor assume no responsibility for teams, any damages, violence, loses and injuries during the stay in Brazil.
Indemnities	<p>The respective national taekwondo associations shall be responsible for ensuring that all officials and participants are covered with effective insurance coverage.</p> <p>Participants without proper participation entry forms and effective insurance coverage will not be allowed to compete at the championships.</p> <p>First Aid will be provided by the organization and is only to be used in case of an emergency.</p>

I hereby recognize, agree, freely and voluntarily accept the nature of the 2022 Rio Open Taekwondo Championships, be held in Rio de Janeiro, Brazil. I attest that I am in good mental health for competition and in proper physical conditions for the above-mentioned event. Therefor if I consider in any moment of the competition, it could be dangerous for my health I will stop my participation. I am fully aware of the following:

- 1) Physical activities imply risks, and I can suffer an injury in any time that can cause, permanent damages, disability, paralysis and death.
- 2) Above mentioned risks could be caused by my own, other contestants or officials' actions or Organizing Committee during the competition.
- 3) Risks may also be social or economic lost that may not be known or predicted by me in this moment. I am aware, accept and assume full responsibility for any costs or damage that can be caused by my participation during the event.

I declare through this document and agree not to sue in any Tribunal against Organizing Committee, Brazilian Taekwondo Federation, Pan American Taekwondo Union (PATU), World Taekwondo for the event to be held in Rio de Janeiro, RJ, Brazil, on April, 16th and 17th, 2022 including organizers, representatives, officials, directives, agents, employees, volunteers and families of each one, as well as any sponsor. All the prior mentioned are released of any responsibility, sue, lost or damages occurred in my person or surroundings that can be caused by myself or the above mentioned in total or partial manner. Therefor any type of lawsuit or legal action will be my responsibility in all risks and economical means, including attorney fees, damages or responsibilities, caused by legal actions.

I have read and fully understand all the terms and conditions. I proceed to sign this document in free will. As parents or legal guardian of under-aged athletes, I fully understand the nature of the activities that will take place. I am fully aware of the experiences that my minor will undertake and declare that the under-aged is healthy and in proper physical conditions to be a contestant for this event. I agree not to sue and further release of any responsibilities to the above-mentioned organizations and individuals for any lost or damages to the defined under-aged athlete.
