In accordance with *Article 4: Qualification of Contestant* of the WT Competition Rules, the contestant must be:

Criterion #1	Holder of nationality of the participating team
Criterion #2	Nominated by Pertinent Member National Association
Criterion #3	Athlete aged 17 years or older (Athletes born in 2007 or before)
Criterion #4	Holder of active WT Global Athlete License(GAL)
Criterion #5	Holder of the Kukkiwon Dan Certificate

7.1 Weigh-In

- * General weigh-in of the contestants shall take place on the day before their respective division
- * During the weigh-in, male contestants shall wear underpants and female contestants shall wear underpants and brassieres. However, contestants may weigh-in in the nude if they wish to do so.

7.2 Substitute athlete(s) shall participate in the weigh-in as well.

7.3 If substitute athlete replaces an existing athlete(s), the total weight of athletes for each event category, including the substitute athlete(s), excluding the replaced athlete(s), shall be recalculated and applied

7. COMPETITION RULES & METHODS

- Single elimination system with bronze medal contest
- Best of Three(3) System, each round shall be carried out with tag match format
- Event Grade : G-8 (Team Ranking)
- Number of Court : One(1)
- Energy Meter Deduction System
 - The “Energy Meter” will be applied, starting with 150 Energy Meter per team
 - Each round, when the “Energy” reaches zero(0), the opponent shall be declared as the winner of the round
 - In case neither teams’ energy meter reach zero(0) within given period, the team with higher energy meter shall be declared as the winner of the round
 - Valid points (Energy Meter) are as follows:

Scoring Area	Energy Meter (Total 150)
Valid Punch to Trunk Protector	-5
Valid Kick to the Trunk Protector	-10
Valid Kick to the Head	-15
Valid Turning Kick to Trunk Protector	-20
Valid Turning Kick to the Head	-25
Gam-jeom	-5
Passive Behavior	Deduction X2 for 10 seconds

- Prohibited acts and penalties : Gam-jeom cases
 - Grabbing the opponent
 - Attacking the opponent after “Kal-yeo”
 - Attacking the fallen opponent
 - Crossing the boundary line
 - Misconduct of contestant(s) or coach
- Penalty on passive contestant : Contestants who are avoiding, or being “passive”, the penalty shall be given to the contestant, and the opponent will have advantage of doubling the points(deducting opponent’s energy meter) within 10 seconds.
 - Passive penalty is given for following cases
 - Running away from the opponent
 - Intentionally falling down
 - Intentionally avoiding or delaying the match
- Substitute(s)
 - Each team may bring maximum six(6) athletes which includes one(1) substitute per gender
 - Replacement of a competitor with the substitute is allowed during rounds
 - In the event of an injury during the competition, a team of three(3) athletes can still be formed and compete.

A. Mixed Team Match Format

- i. Each team must have at least 2 female athletes and 2 male athletes, with a maximum entry of 6 athletes, including 2 substitutes(1 substitute per gender)
- ii. Athletes are numbered from 1(lighter) to 2(heavier) for female and 3(lighter) and 4(heavier) for male athletes, substitute numbered 5(female) and 6(male)
- iii. All contest shall be carried out for 3(or 2) rounds(3 minutes per round) with 1 minute break between rounds.
- iv. The 1st round shall start with Choice of Chung's female athlete
- v. The 2nd round shall start with choice of Hong's female athlete
- vi. In case of 3rd round, it shall start with the male athlete, and each side must match same gender for every bout
- vii. Replacement of competitors(tag) shall be allowed without any limit, but each competitor must fight for 15 seconds or more to be replaced. Replacement can only be made if the match is reasonably interrupted.
- viii. In case replacement is made, the opposing team cannot make any replacement for 10 seconds unless the tag must be made to match the gender for bout
- ix. The team which reaches 40 Gam-jeom during any point of the match will be declared loser
- x. There is no point gap
- xi. Male athletes are required Black Dobok pants

8. WT GLOBAL LICENCE & ONLINE REGISTRATION

- i. WT Global Licence Registration
All athletes and team officials must FIRST be registered with a WT Global Athlete Licence (GAL) or Global Official Licence (GOL).
- ii. WT Online Registration
Entry will only be accepted through the WT online registration system and registration is only possible with a valid WT Global Licence.

9. ENTRY FEES

The entry fees from the participating athletes are collected onsite with US Dollar only. Athletes shall not be allowed to compete without successful payment of entry fee.

Note: Additional athlete will not be accepted at the registration center, only athletes who are registered online shall be the ones competing after the payment made at the registration center.

REGULAR ENTRY FEES: Teams completing their registration during this period will be charged the regular registration fee.

- US \$500 per team to be paid in cash onsite
- Registration will begin on October 23, 2024, 17:01, local time in Switzerland.
- Registration will end on November 25, 2024, 18:00, local time in Switzerland.
- Any WT Global Licence registration completed onsite will be charged a US\$50 onsite processing fee for each WT Global Licence required.
- Each MNA can register online for maximum
 - o One(1) Head of Team
 - o One(1) Manager
 - o Two(2) Coaches
 - o One(1) Team doctor
 - o Three(3) MNA Officials

10. CLASSIFICATION OF RESULTS

Medals will be awarded to the top three teams in the respective weight category of the pertinent competition:

1st PLACE:	GOLD MEDALS & CERTIFICATES and Prize Money Trophy & USD 20,000 to the team and gold medals to all the pertinent team
2nd PLACE:	SILVER MEDALS & CERTIFICATES and Prize Money Trophy & USD 10,000 to the team and silver medals to all the pertinent team
3rd PLACE:	BRONZE MEDALS & CERTIFICATES and Prize Money Trophy & USD 5,000 to the and bronze medals to all the pertinent team

11. WT-RECOGNIZED TAEKWONDO COMPETITION UNIFORM AND PROTECTIVE EQUIPMENT

- i. **KPNP Protector and Scoring System (PSS) including PSS Headgear** will be used for the competition.
- ii. Participating contestants are required to wear **WT-recognized Kyorugi competition uniform or Dobok** and WT-recognized protective equipment. **Male contestants must wear black Dobok pants.** The latest version of WT-recognized manufacturers' list is available at the website of WT (<http://www.worldtaekwondo.org/wtpartners-wt/recognize.html>).
- iii. The Organizing Committee will provide Protector and Scoring System (PSS) to the participating contestants. Participating contestants are required to bring their own groin guards, mouthguard, gloves, sensing socks and shin and forearm guards for their personal use.
- iv. Before entering the field of play, all contestants will proceed to the inspection desk for inspection of their competition uniform and protective equipment. **Any contestants who wear unofficial competition uniform, Dobok or protective equipment will not be permitted to compete.**
- v. The top has to cover completely the buttocks. However, the bottom of top should be more than 15cm above the knee cap

12. IDENTIFICATION OF NOC CODE AND MANUFACTURER

- i. National flag shall be located between 3 to 3.5cm below from the shoulder line of the right arm.
- ii. NOC Code is a three-letter National Olympic committee abbreviation, and it must be printed at the back in black and centred at 5cm or higher from the bottom line of the upper garment within the size of 30cm width x 12cm height. The font of the letters shall be in bold "Verdana".
- iii. Manufacturer's identifications (name, designation trademark, logo or any distinctive sign of the manufacturer) shall be located one for the top of Kyorugi competition uniform or Dobok within 30cm² and between 3 to 3.5cm below the shoulder line of the left arm, one for bottoms of Kyorugi competition uniform or Dobok within 30cm² located above the knee and center of the right leg, and one for Kyorugi belt within 6cm² at the end of the belt.

13. SPONSOR'S IDENTIFICATION

- i. ONE sponsor's identification (logo) is allowed to each of Kyorugi competition uniform or Dobok's top and bottoms.
- ii. The sponsor's identification shall be located within 50cm² except the location of WT logo, manufacturer's identification, national flag, and NOC code.

14. MEDICAL CONTROL

- i. The WT Anti-Doping Rules, and where necessary the Code of the World Anti-Doping Agency, shall apply throughout the competitions.
- ii. Compulsory anti-doping tests will be carried out for selected medalists, while random tests will be conducted to the rest of the athletes. The WT and/or WADA may carry out random out-of-competition testing prior to the championships.
- iii. TUE (Therapeutic Use Exemption)

Athletes who take any substance or medicine listed in the "Prohibited List" of the WT Anti-Doping Rules and Anti-Doping Code of World Anti-Doping Agency (WADA) for therapeutic purposes are requested to submit TUE applications via ADAMS, together with the required medical information. If you do not have an ADAMS account yet, please contact tue@ita.sport to have it set up.

Otherwise, please download the TUE Application Form and once duly completed and signed, send it together with the required medical file to tue@ita.sport with copy to antidoping@worldtaekwondo.org, by at least 30 days before the first competition day.

15. HEAD OF TEAM MEETING & DRAWING OF LOTS SESSION

- i. The head of team meeting shall be conducted one (1) day prior to the start of the competition that is December 9th, in the presence of the WT officials and the representatives of the participating teams.
- ii. At least one representative from each team must attend the head of team meeting. In case of no representative can be at the meeting, the team must designate a proxy and inform Technical Delegate or WT Sport & Event Management department before the meeting.
- iii. The method of draw shall be decided by the Technical Delegate

16. INDEMNITIES

- i. The respective national taekwondo associations shall be responsible for ensuring that all officials and participants are covered with effective travel & medical insurance coverage.
- ii. Participants without proper insurance coverage will not be allowed to compete at the competition.
- iii. The Organizing Committee will acquire general Public Liability event insurance.

17. VISA INFORMATION

The Organizing Committee can provide invitation letters for visa applications. However, MNAs are required to check the China entry visa application waiting times in their own countries and submit requests for invitation letters to the organizing committee.

The Organizing Committee cannot guarantee entry into China and can only offer assistance. It is the responsibility of each athlete and MNA to apply for and secure the correct entry visa for China MNA's are requested to complete the attached visa application form at least one week before the waiting time deadline in their own country.

The visa invitation letter from OC will be sent within 3 working days after request, yet the other visa invitation letter with bar code issued by Chinese Government will be sent in 10-15 working days, which is necessary for people from these countries: IRI, TUR, PAK, UZB, KAZ, LKA, YEM, LBN, COD, TUN, AZE, CMR (*FYI, please consult your Chinese Embassy for details). The DEADLINE for Invitation letter request is November 29th, 2024.

18. COACH'S REQUIREMENTS

All coaches are required to hold WT Coach Certificate Level (2). **Coaches who do not hold Level II coach certificate will be deleted from the registration and not allowed to coach at the Championships**

All coaches are required to wear formal suit such as tie, jacket, dress shirt (long or short), and trousers, and sport shoes during Semi-Finals and Finals. Any type of cap/hat is not allowed. If any coach refuses to wear abovementioned attire, he or she will not be allowed to coach for the event.

19. TECHNICAL OFFICIALS

WT will appoint total of 20 International Referees. The appointed International Referees shall officiate at Wuxi 2024 World Taekwondo World Cup Team Championships Final; Following conditions shall apply:

1. Round trip airfare shall be borne by respective International Referees
2. The Organizing Committee shall be responsible for room and board for three(3) nights as well as the transportation from/to the airport
 - A. Check in : December 8 / Check out : December 11
3. The Organizing Committee shall pay per diem of USD 150 to the appointed International Referee for competition days and training day (total 2 days; 300 USD per International Referee)

WT will appoint one(1) Technical Delegate and up to four(4) members of the Competition Supervisory Board. Following conditions shall apply:

1. The Organizing Committee shall cover the round trip airfare
2. The Organizing Committee shall be responsible for room and board for three(3) nights as well as the transportation from/to the airport
 - A. Check in : December 8 / Check out : December 11
3. The Organizing Committee shall pay per diem of USD 200 to the appointed Technical Delegate and Competition Supervisory Board members for competition days and training day (total 2 days; 400 USD per official)
